

INSTALLING A CASTLE BAY SINK

There are several ways an undermount sink can be mounted. A professional fabricator will select the appropriate method to securely mount the sink under the countertop.

There are three styles to install an undermount sink, depending on individual preference. **Note that Castle Bay template is only be used as reference, and the actual sink should be present to ensure an accurate cutout.** Castle Bay Sinks Inc. assumes no liability for any damages incurred through its application.

Undermount Style Options:

FLUSH MOUNT

The edge of the countertop cutout opening is aligned with the edge of the sink rim on all sides. No reveal or very little of the sink rim is visible as the countertop is flushed with the sink bowls.

a. flush mount



OVERHANG MOUNT

The edge of the countertop cutout opening extends beyond the edge of the sink rim on all sides. No sink rim is visible as it is hidden under the counter edge.

b. overhang



REVEAL MOUNT

The sink rim extends from the edge of the countertop cutout opening on all sides. The amount of reveal is flexible – more or less depending on the look that is desired. Deciding on your preferred look must be done prior to cutout of the countertop.
